Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Section 1. Chapter 90 of the General laws, as amended in chapter 155 of the acts of
- 2 2010, is amended by inserting after Section 13B, the following new section:-
- 3 Section 13C. A person, regardless of age, may not use a mobile telephone at any time
- 4 while operating a motor vehicle on a public way in a school zone established by a city or town
- 5 pursuant to section 2 of chapter 85. This section does not apply to (i) a person using a wireless
- 6 telephone for emergency purposes, including, but not limited to, law enforcement agency, health
- 7 care provider, fire department, or other emergency services agency or entity or (ii) a law
- 8 enforcement officer or operator of an emergency vehicle when performing the officer's or
- 9 operator's official duties.
