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The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Jason Saunders, an employee of the Department of Correction.

*Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to establish forthwith a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the Department of Correction, , therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law, or rule or regulation to the  
2 contrary, the Department of Correction shall establish a sick leave bank for Jason Saunders, an  
3 employee of the Department. Any employee of the department may voluntarily contribute 1 or  
4 more of his sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Jason Saunders.  
5 Whenever Jason Saunders terminates employment with the Department or requests to dissolve  
6 the sick leave bank, the balance shall be transferred to the extended illness leave bank. Sick leave  
7 bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the  
8 establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the Department of Correction.
