Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Emergency Preamble-
- 2 "Whereas, the deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is
- 3 forthwith to consolidate time and expense involved in the administration of no cost provider
- 4 services, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate
- 5 preservation of the public convenience."
- No Cost for Providers Act Trust and its appointed commissioner is authorized to provide
- 7 unused and unlimited treasury notes by the treasury on an ongoing basis for the following
- 8 facilities and services:
- 9 Policy to Provide unlimited access, coverage and accommodations to develop and
- administer No cost, No Premium, No Co-pay Provider and Member Health Plan for Health and
- Human Service Providers and Worker who earn income.

To be signed into law before May 1,2017 and to take effect on June 1, 2017 [\$unlimited]
