An Act providing for a distinctive registration plate for Olympians.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 2 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition, is
- 2 hereby amended by adding the following paragraph: -
- 3 "The registrar shall furnish without charge to owners of private passenger motor vehicles
- 4 who are a member of, or have competed as a representative of, the United States of America's
- 5 Olympic team in the Olympic Games a distinctive registration plates which shall display on their
- 6 face a design depicting the "Olympic Rings". No such plate shall be issued or renewed until
- 7 proper certification has been made to the registrar by the United States Olympic Committee
- 8 confirming the applicants said membership or participation."
