## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

**In the Year Two Thousand Eleven**

An Act providing for a distinctive registration plate for Olympians.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 2 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition, is  
2 hereby amended by adding the following paragraph: -

3 “The registrar shall furnish without charge to owners of private passenger motor vehicles  
4 who are a member of, or have competed as a representative of, the United States of America’s  
5 Olympic team in the Olympic Games a distinctive registration plates which shall display on their  
6 face a design depicting the “Olympic Rings”. No such plate shall be issued or renewed until  
7 proper certification has been made to the registrar by the United States Olympic Committee  
8 confirming the applicants said membership or participation.”
