**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)**

An Act relative to motor vehicle registration plates.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 2 of Chapter 90 of the General Laws as appearing in the 2008
2 official edition is hereby amended in the seventh paragraph, line 2, by striking the words “two
3 number plates of suitable design” and inserting the words “one number plate of suitable design to
4 be placed at the rear of the vehicle”,

5 SECTION 2. Section 6 of Chapter 90 of the General Laws as appearing in the 2008
6 official edition is hereby amended in line 6 by striking the following words: “at the front and”.
