- 4 therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation
- 5 of the public convenience."
- 6 Employment Act Trust and its appointed commissioner is authorized to provide unused
- 7 and unlimited treasury notes by the treasury on an ongoing basis for the following facilities and
- 8 services:
- Policy to provide unlimited access, coverage and accommodations for persons who seek
