An Act relative to the Employment Act.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Emergency Preamble-

2           “Whereas, the deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is  
3 forthwith to consolidate time and expense involved in the administration of employment,  
4 therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation  
5 of the public convenience.”

6           Employment Act Trust and its appointed commissioner is authorized to provide unused  
7 and unlimited treasury notes by the treasury on an ongoing basis for the following facilities and  
8 services:

9           Policy to provide unlimited access, coverage and accommodations for persons who seek  
10 employment support and services. [\$unlimited]
