Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 115, Section 5 of the Massachusetts General Laws, as appearing in
- 2 the 2004 Official edition is hereby amended by striking out paragraph eight and inserting in
- 3 place thereof the following paragraphs: --
- The benefits provided herein shall include an amount for "Shelter" not to fall below \$600
- 5 per month for eligible veterans and dependents who do not pay their own heating costs.
- The benefits provided herein shall include an amount for "Shelter" not to fall below \$500
- 7 per month for eligible veterans and dependents who pay their own heating costs.
