An Act relative to billboards.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 29 of chapter 93 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "located", in line 20, the 3 following words: - "; provided, however, that the board shall not grant or renew any license or 4 permit for a proposed or existing billboard, sign or other advertising device if the same is not 5 expressly permitted by the zoning ordinance or by-law of the city or town in which it is located 6 or proposed to be located, and if such city or town notifies the board in writing of its desire that 7 such billboard, sign or other advertising device be removed or not be erected".

8 SECTION 2. Section 29A of said chapter 93, as so appearing, is hereby amended by 9 inserting after the first sentence, in line 8, the following sentence: - "The board shall not grant or 10 renew any license or permit for a proposed or existing billboard, sign or other advertising device 11 if the same is not expressly permitted by the zoning ordinance or by-law of the city or town in 12 which it is located or proposed to be located, and if such city or town notifies the board in

- 13 writing of its desire that such billboard, sign or other advertising device be removed or not be
- 14 erected."
