An Act designating January as peace officer history month.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 6 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016 Official Edition, is hereby  
2 amended by inserting after section 15BBBBBB the following section:-

3 Section 15CCCCC. The governor shall annually issue a proclamation setting apart the  
4 month of January as Peace Officer History Month and recommend that the month be observed in  
5 an appropriate manner by the people.
