An Act relative to child passenger safety.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 7AA of chapter 90 of the General Laws, is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting “and be seated in the rear passenger seat of the motor vehicle whenever possible” to the
- 3 end of the second paragraph.
