- 2 hereby amended by inserting after clause Nineteenth the following clause:-
- Nineteenth A. Merchandise situated in Massachusetts, including inventory held for sale;
- 4 finished goods; products, goods, wares or stock in trade; work in progress; materials or supplies;
- 5 and archived or stored goods.
