AN ACT TO INCLUDE THREE ADDITIONAL MEMBERS ON THE ADVISORY COMMISSION  
ON TRAVEL AND TOURISM.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority  
of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 23A, Section 13C of the Massachusetts General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by in the third paragraph by changing the number “31” to “34” in line 21; and by  
3 inserting the following after the word “services” in line 45: “and one each to be selected by the  
4 Governor, the President of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House.”
