**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court
(2021-2022)**

An Act extending the historic rehabilitation tax credit program.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Paragraph (i) of subsection (b) of section 38R of chapter 63, as so appearing
2 in the 2018 official edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 38, the figure “2022” and
3 inserting in place thereof the following figure:- 2027.

4 SECTION 2. Said paragraph (i) of said subsection (b) of said section 38R of said chapter
5 63 is hereby further amended by striking out, in line 40, the figure “\$55,000,000” and inserting
6 in place thereof the following figure: \$65,000,000.
