In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act relative to aiding municipal events.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 14 of chapter 138 of the General Laws, as so appearing in the 2016

2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the second paragraph and inserting in place

3 thereof the following paragraph:-

A nonprofit charitable corporation organized pursuant to chapter 180 and registered with the division of public charities in the department of the attorney general and licensed pursuant to this section, or the chief procurement officer or purchasing agent of a municipality government, may accept free alcoholic beverages donated to the nonprofit charitable corporation or municipality government by an individual or, by a person licensed to manufacture alcoholic beverages or by a person licensed to sell alcoholic beverages at wholesale or retail pursuant to this chapter. Any such donated alcoholic beverages shall only be for the purpose of serving such
