In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act to promote and advance motorcycle safety.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 34 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "safety", in line 7, the following
- words:-; provided, however, that the registrar shall provide rebates of not less than \$100 to
- 4 persons under the age of 21 who successfully complete a motorcycle basic rider course approved
- 5 by the registrar pursuant to section 8 and that the total of such rebates shall not exceed 20 per
- 6 cent of the funds so deposited.
