# The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Teresa Amato, an employee of the Executive Office of Health and Human Services.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the department of Executive

2 Office of Health and Human Services shall establish a sick leave bank for Teresa Amato, an

3 employee of the department. Any employee of the department may voluntarily contribute 1 or

4 more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Teresa Amato. Whenever

5 Teresa Amato terminates employment with the department or requests to dissolve the sick leave

6 bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the extended illness leave

7 bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability

8 that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the department.
