**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act directing the Massachusetts Department of Transportation to conduct a highway noise study in Quincy.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the
2 Massachusetts Department of Transportation is hereby directed to conduct a comprehensive
3 noise study along the northbound and southbound sides of Route I-93 in the city of Quincy from
4 exit 10, Squantum Street/Milton to the I- 93/Route 3 split, to determine the ambient noise level
5 generated by the existing Route I-93 traffic. Said study shall be conducted by an acoustical
6 engineer employed by or on behalf of the Massachusetts Department of Transportation.
