An Act relative to net school spending in fiscal year 2014.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regulation to the  
2 contrary, the commissioner of elementary and secondary education shall not include deficiencies  
3 in net school spending requirements attributed to the non-inclusion of health care costs for retired  
4 teachers when calculating state school aid distribution reductions under section 11 of chapter 70  
5 of the General Laws in fiscal year 2014.
