An Act relative to pedestrian safety.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           The first sentence of section 24 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the  
2 2014 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "licensees", in line 3, the  
3 following words:-

4           "as motorists or pedestrians"
