## AN ACT RELATIVE TO REVOCATION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Paragraph (2) of subsection (e) of Section 5 of Chapter 23I, as added by section 13  
2 of chapter 130 of the acts of 2008, is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the  
3 following:-

4 The Secretary must revoke certification when two consecutive independent investigations  
5 determine that representations made by the life sciences sector business in its project proposal  
6 are materially at variance with the conduct of the life sciences sector business after the  
7 certification, and the actual return on investment by the life sciences sector business is less than  
8 70 per cent of the return on investment projected in the project proposal.
