AN ACT RELATIVE TO VETERAN'S WORK RELATED EXPERIENCE IN APPLYING FOR
CERTAIN LICENSES .

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 23 of the General Laws, is hereby amended by adding the
2 following section:- Section 25. Notwithstanding any other general or special law to the contrary
3 veterans who reside in the Commonwealth may be exempted from apprenticeship, school and
4 other requirements to acquire a permit or license to perform work in an area requiring a license.
5 The commissioner shall promulgate rules and regulations to award veterans exemption from
6 requirements or credits towards licensure for all related military experience and schooling in the
7 area in which the veteran seeks to be licensed. The rules and regulations shall include but not be
8 limited to accepting military training and work experience in lieu of apprenticeship fully or
9 partially, as the licensing authority determines, the veteran from apprenticeship and other
10 requirements.
