By Mr. O'Connor, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1997) of Patrick M. O'Connor, Mark J. Cusack, Josh S. Cutler, James K. Hawkins and other members of the General Court for legislation relative to compressor stations. Telecommunications, Utilities and Energy.

**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court
(2019-2020)**

An Act relative to compressor stations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, no new natural
2 gas compressor stations shall be located in an area which is less than 0.5 miles in linear distance
3 from: (i) a playground;(ii) a licensed day care center; (iii) a school; (iv) a church; (v) an
4 environmental justice population neighborhood; (vi) an area of critical environmental concern as
5 determined by the secretary of environmental affairs under 301 CMR 12.00; (vii) a waterway
6 preserved and protected for water-dependent uses under chapter 91; or (viii) an area occupied by
7 residential housing. Linear distance shall be measured from any point along a natural gas
8 compressor station to the outermost point of buildings or areas in clauses (i) to (viii), inclusive;
9 provided, however, that repairs or replacements that do not increase the capacity of a natural gas
10 compressor station in operation prior to January 1, 2019, shall not be subject to this section. For
11 the purposes of this section, “environmental justice population neighborhood” shall mean a
12 neighborhood with an annual median household income of not more than 65 per cent of the
13 statewide median income or with a segment of the population that consists of residents that is not

14 less than 25 per cent minority, foreign born or lacking in English language proficiency based on
15 the most recent United States census.”; and

16 by adding the following section:-

17 “SECTION 33. Section 22A shall take effect upon a determination by the attorney
18 general that the section is constitutional.”
