An Act establishing the official dinosaur of the commonwealth.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 2 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 116 of the acts of
2 2020, is hereby further amended by adding the following section:-

3 The Podokesaurus holyokensis shall be the official dinosaur of the Commonwealth.
