By Ms. Chandler, a petition (subject to Joint Rule 12) (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 2029) of Harriette L. Chandler and Vincent A. Pedone for legislation to authorize the Massachusetts Department of Transportation to acquire certain parcels of land in the city of Worcester. Transportation.

An Act authorizing the Massachusetts Department of Transportation to acquire certain parcels of land in the city of Worcester.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1: The Massachusetts Department of Transportation is, hereby, authorized
2 to acquire by eminent domain, purchase or otherwise certain parcels of land in the City of
3 Worcester described in Section 2 herein below from the Massachusetts Department of
4 Conservation and Recreation. The parcels are to be diverted from their present use as open space
5 to a highway use.

6 SECTION 2: The description of the above referenced parcels is as follows:

7 Parcel 61-3-C: A parcel of land dedicated to an open space use supposed to be owned
8 by the Massachusetts Department of Conservation and Recreation, adjoining the easterly sideline
9 of the City Layout of Lake Avenue North and bounded as follows: Beginning on the easterly
10 line of said City Layout at the northwesterly corner of the parcel hereinafter described; thence

11 southeasterly a distance of about 3.3 feet; thence southwesterly a distance of about 29.0 feet;
12 thence along a curve to the left having a radius of about 47.0 feet, a distance of about 66.3 feet to
13 a point on the northerly sideline of the City Layout of Route 9; thence continuing southwesterly
14 along said City Layout a distance of about 61.2 feet to a point on the easterly sideline of the City
15 Layout of Lake Avenue North; thence continuing northeasterly along said City Layout a
16 distance of about 86.4 feet to the point of beginning. Said parcel containing about 1,273 square
17 feet.

18 Parcel 61-W-2-C: A parcel of land dedicated to an open space use supposed to be
19 owned by the Massachusetts Department of Conservation and Recreation, adjoining the easterly
20 sideline of the City Layout of Lake Avenue North and bounded as follows: Beginning on the
21 easterly line of said City Layout at the northwesterly corner of the parcel hereinafter described;
22 thence southeasterly a distance of about 11.6 feet; thence southwesterly a distance of about 52.4
23 feet; thence along a curve to the left having a radius of about 39.0 feet, a distance of about 59.6
24 feet; thence southeasterly a distance of about 8.4 feet to the southeasterly corner of the
25 aforementioned Parcel 61-3-C; thence continuing along the easterly sideline of said parcel along
26 a curve to the right having a radius of about 47.0 feet, a distance of about 66.3 feet; thence
27 northeasterly a distance of about 29.0 feet; thence northwesterly a distance of about 3.3 feet to a
28 point on the easterly sideline of the City Layout of Lake Avenue North; thence leaving said
29 Parcel 61-3-C and continuing northeasterly along the easterly sideline of the City Layout of Lake
30 Avenue North a distance of about 39.4 feet to the point of beginning. Said parcel containing
31 about 985 square feet.

32 Parcel 61-WD-1: A parcel of land dedicated to an open space use supposed to be
33 owned by the Massachusetts Department of Conservation and Recreation, adjoining the northerly

34 sideline of the City Layout of Route 9 and bounded as follows: Beginning on the northerly line
35 of said City Layout at the southeasterly corner of the aforementioned Parcel 61-W-2-C; thence
36 continuing northeasterly along said City Layout a distance of about 145.8 feet to a point on the
37 easterly sideline of the property supposed to be owned by the Massachusetts Department of
38 Conservation and Recreation; thence continuing northeasterly along said easterly sideline a
39 distance of about 24.2 feet; thence leaving said sideline and continuing northwesterly a distance
40 of about 114.0 feet; thence southwesterly a distance of about 46.1; thence southeasterly a
41 distance of about 34.5 feet to the point of beginning. Said parcel containing about 4,317 square
42 feet.

43 SECTION 3: The aforesaid parcels of land are shown on a plan entitled “
44 Worcester/Shrewsbury Route 9 Over Lake Quinsigamond Preliminary Right Of Way Property
45 Plan Sheet 2 Of 9”. This plan is on file with the Chief Engineer of the Highway Division of the
46 Massachusetts Department of Transportation.

47 SECTION 4: The Massachusetts Department of Transportation is, hereby, authorized
48 to acquire by eminent domain, purchase or otherwise certain parcels of land in the City of
49 Worcester described in Section 2 herein below from the Commonwealth of Massachusetts
50 University of Massachusetts (UMASS). The parcels are to be diverted from their present use as
51 higher education to a highway use.

52 SECTION 5: The description of the above referenced parcels is as follows:

53 Parcel 61-2-C: A parcel of land dedicated to a higher education use supposed to be
54 owned by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts UMASS, adjoining the northerly sideline of the
55 City Layout of Belmont Street (Route 9) and bounded as follows: Beginning on the northerly

56 line of said City Layout at the southwesterly corner of the parcel hereinafter described; thence
57 northwesterly a distance of about 9.6 feet along the westerly sideline of the property supposed to
58 be owned by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts UMASS; thence northeasterly a distance of
59 about 140.7 feet; thence continuing northeasterly a distance of about 114.5 feet; thence
60 continuing northeasterly a distance of about 10.0 feet; thence continuing northeasterly a distance
61 of about 50.9 feet to a point on the westerly sideline of the City Layout of Lake Avenue North;
62 thence southwesterly along said City Layout a distance of about 21.4 feet to a point on the
63 northerly sideline of the City Layout of Belmont Street (Route 9); thence leaving the City Layout
64 of Lake Avenue North and continuing southwesterly along the City Layout of Belmont Street
65 (Route 9) a distance of about 298.1 feet to the point of beginning. Said parcel containing about
66 3,329 square feet.

67 Parcel 61-W-1-C: A parcel of land dedicated to a higher education use supposed to
68 be owned by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts UMASS, adjoining the northerly sideline the
69 aforementioned Parcel 61-2-C and bounded as follows: Beginning at a point on the northerly
70 sideline of Parcel 61-2-C at the southwesterly corner of the parcel hereinafter described; thence
71 northeasterly a distance of about 32.6 feet; thence continuing northeasterly a distance of about
72 40.4 feet; thence continuing northeasterly a distance of about 21.5 feet; thence continuing
73 northeasterly a distance of about 21.3 feet to a point along the northerly sideline of said Parcel
74 61-2-C; thence continuing southwesterly along the sideline of said Parcel 61-2-C a distance of
75 about 10.0 feet; thence continuing southwesterly along said sideline a distance of about 114.5
76 feet to the point of beginning said parcel containing about 792 square feet.

77 SECTION 6: The afore-referenced parcel delineated as Parcel 61-2-C is shown on a
78 plan entitled "Worcester/Shrewsbury Route 9 over Lake Quinsigamond Preliminary Right of

79 Way Property Plan Sheet 1 of 9". The afore-referenced parcel delineated as Parcel 61-W-1-C is
80 shown on a plan entitled "Worcester/Shrewsbury Route 9 over Lake Quinsigamond Preliminary
81 Right of Way Property Plan Sheet 2 of 9". These plans are on file with the Chief Engineer of the
82 Highway Division of the Massachusetts Department of Transportation.
