AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE APPOINTMENT OF A CERTAIN CIVIL SERVICE CLASS AS FIREFIGHTERS IN THE CITY OF BOSTON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding chapter 31 of the General Laws or any other general or
2 special law to the contrary regulating the civil service appointment of firefighter, the next
3 original appointments to the lowest title in the regular Fire Department force in the City of
4 Boston shall be made from the class designated as Fire Fighter Certification #28 – 0786, dated
5 August 12, 2008 and August 15, 2008.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage and shall expire on June 30,
7 2011.
