Senate, October 22, 2015 -- Substituted as a new draft (Senator McGee) for the Senate Bill authorizing the city of Lynn to grant an additional liquor license for the sale of wine and malt beverages not to be drunk on the premises (Senate, No. 40)

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act authorizing the city of Lynn to grant 1 additional license for the sale of all alcoholic beverages not to be drunk on the premises.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Notwithstanding section 17 of chapter 138 of the General Laws, the
- 2 licensing board of the city of Lynn may grant 1 additional license for the sale of all alcoholic
- 3 beverages not to be drunk on the premises under section 15 of said chapter 138 to Anthony Leo
- 4 d/b/a as the T-Stop Superette located at 546 Walnut street. The license shall be subject to all of
- 5 said chapter 138 except said section 17.
- The licensing board shall not approve the transfer of the license to any other location but
- 7 it may grant the license to a new applicant at the same location if the applicant files with the
- 8 licensing board a letter from the department of revenue and a letter from the department of
- 9 unemployment assistance indicating that the license is in good standing with those departments
- 10 and that all applicable taxes, fees and contributions have been paid.
- If the license granted pursuant to this act is cancelled, revoked or no longer in use, it shall
- 12 be returned physically, with all legal rights, privileges and restrictions pertaining thereto, to the

- 13 licensing board and the licensing board may then grant the license to a new applicant at the same
- 14 location under the same conditions as specified in this act.
- SECTION 2. This shall take effect upon its passage.
