In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Sharon J. Nolan, an employee of the Trial Court.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to establish a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the trial court, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the
2	department of probation shall establish a sick leave bank for Sharon J. Nolan, an employee of the
3	department of probation in the office of community corrections. Any employee of the department
4	of probation may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick
5	leave bank for use by Sharon J. Nolan. Whenever Sharon J. Nolan terminates employment with
6	the probation department or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time in the
7	sick leave bank shall be transferred to the trial court paid leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall
8	not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the establishment
9	of the sick leave bank as determined by the probation department.
