1 Ordered, that there shall be a special committee on the part of the Senate on cyber 2 security readiness. The committee shall consist of 5 members of the Senate, 4 of whom shall be 3 appointed by the President of the Senate and 1 of whom shall be appointed by the Minority 4 Leader of the Senate. The committee shall review and make recommendations for the state to 5 improve its cyber security readiness, enhance technological responses to homeland security and 6 public safety threats, and further protect financial, medical and other sensitive information. The 7 committee shall file its report, with any recommendations for legislation, with the clerk of the 8 senate by March 30, 2018.
