A nonprofit charitable corporation organized pursuant to chapter 180 and registered with

the division of public charities in the department of the attorney general and licensed pursuant to

this section, or the chief procurement officer or purchasing agent of a municipality government,

may accept free alcoholic beverages donated to the nonprofit charitable corporation or

municipality government by an individual or, by a person licensed to manufacture alcoholic
