An Act designating World Voice Week..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 6 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010 Official Edition, is hereby
2 amended by inserting after Section 1500000 the following section:-

3 Section 15PPPPP. The governor shall annually issue a proclamation setting apart a week
4 beginning on April 16 as World Voice Week, in recognition of the many citizens of the
5 commonwealth suffering from voice disorders, the need for increased awareness amongst
6 medical professionals and the general public to support those affected and their families and
7 recommending that the week be observed in an appropriate manner by the people.
