## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act pertaining to the town of Bellingham and water main easement.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding sections 34 to 37, inclusive, of chapter 7C of the General
Laws, the commissioner of capital asset management and maintenance, in consultation with the
commissioner of conservation and recreation, may grant an easement upon a certain parcel of
land, currently under the care and control of the department of conservation and recreation and
held for conservation and recreation purposes to town of Bellingham, to be used for the purposes
of installation and maintenance of a raw water transmission main, subject to the requirements of
sections 2 through 5, inclusive, and to such additional terms and conditions consistent with this
act as the commissioner of capital asset management and maintenance may prescribe in
consultation with the commissioner of conservation and recreation. The parcel of land contains
37,000 square feet, more or less, and is shown on a plan of land entitled Bellingham Department
of Public Works South Raw Water Main to be filed with Norfolk county registry of deeds. Prior
