1	Section 3 of chapter 268B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018 Official Edition,

2 is hereby amended by striking subsection (a) and inserting in place thereof, the following

3 subsection:-

4 (a) Prescribe and publish, pursuant to chapter 30A, rules and regulations: (1) to carry

5 out this chapter, including rules governing the conduct or proceedings hereunder; and (2) to carry

6 out chapter 268A, including but not limited to exemptions from the provisions of said chapter
