An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Sharyn LeCesse, an employee of the registry of motor vehicles.

*Whereas*, the deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is forthwith to establish forthwith a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the registry of motor vehicles, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law, or rule or regulation to the contrary, the  
2 registry of motor vehicles shall establish a sick leave bank for Sharyn LeCesse, an employee of  
3 the registry. Any employee of the registry may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or  
4 vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Sharyn LeCesse. Whenever Sharyn LeCesse  
5 terminates employment with the registry or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any  
6 remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the extended illness leave bank.

- 7 Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that
- 8 necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the registry.
