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**In the Year Two Thousand Fourteen**  
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An Act relative to a betterment assessment in the town of Sturbridge.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the expiration of the six-month appeal period in section 5  
2 of chapter 80 of the General Laws or any other general or special law to the contrary, the town of  
3 Sturbridge may abate a sewer betterment assessment on a parcel of land in the town, known as  
4 47 Hillcrest Street.
