#### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act relative to charitable donation of automobiles.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Any person within the commonwealth who donates an automobile to any 2 charitable fund or organization or other entity established pursuant to the United States Internal 3 Revenue Service section 501(c)(3), in which a certificate of title is held and in the name of the 4 donor, shall file with the Registry of Motor Vehicles a notice of such donation and a copy of an 5 acknowledgement, in writing, from the so-called 501(c)(3) entity, within seven (7) days of 6 receipt of said acknowledgement. The date of receipt from the so-called charitable fund or 7 organization shall be deemed the date of donation. Any person who provides notice to the 8 Registry of such donation shall not be liable for any costs of abandonment or loss of the donated 9 automobile.
