In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act relative to protecting residents from hazardous traffic conditions.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

SECTION 1. Chapter 21C is hereby amended by inserting after section 12 the following
section:-

3 Section 13. No facility governed by section 150A or 150A1/2 of chapter 111 shall be

4 constructed unless said facility is constructed in a municipality that has direct access to a road

5 designated as an expressway by the Massachusetts Department of Transportation, and no

6 building permit shall be issued for such a facility unless the applicant has demonstrated such

7 direct access.
