Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 23K of the Massachusetts General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after section 58 the following section:-
- 3 Section 58a. (a) All slot machines must be affixed with a sticker delineating the (1)
- 4 Addictive nature of slot machines; (2) Information regarding the programming and therefore
- 5 non-randomness of slot machines; and (3) the compulsive gambling hotline phone number.
- 6 (b) The stickers shall be affixed to the front of the machine, in plain sight of the user of
- 7 the machine.
