An Act to maintain short term objectives for students with disabilities.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 71B, Section 3 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by inserting the following sentence after line 137:

3 A child's individualized education program, or IEP, as defined is 20 USC sec
4 1401 (14) shall include a statement of measurable annual goals, including academic and
5 functional goals, and a description of benchmarks or short-term objectives.
