In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act to create a deposit for glass wine and liquor bottles.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 321 of Chapter 94 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby
- 2 amended by striking the definition of "Beverage" and inserting in place thereof the following
- 3 definition:-
- 4 "Beverage", soda water or similar carbonated soft drinks, mineral water, beer and other
- 5 malt beverages, alcoholic beverages, liquor, and wine, but shall not include dairy products and
- 6 natural fruit juices.
- 7 SECTION 2. The executive office of energy and environmental affairs shall promulgate
- 8 regulations and guidelines as necessary to implement the provisions of this act.
