### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Twelve

#### An Act relative to simulcasting.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Notwithstanding section 2 of chapter 128C of the General Laws or any other general or
- 2 special law to the contrary, in calendar year 2012, no racing meeting licensee located in Suffolk
- 3 or Norfolk county shall simulcast live races in a racing season unless the racing meeting licensee
- 4 is licensed to and actually conducts at least 720 live races over the course of not less than 80
- 5 calendar days during the 2012 racing season with no fewer than 7 races completed on any of
- 6 those 80 calendar days.
