An Act relative to increasing City of Gloucester parking fines.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary upon approval by  
2 the city council or mayor, the City of Gloucester may raise any parking fines established chapter  
3 section 20A 1/2, provided further that any fine established under chapter 90 section 20A 1/2 for  
4 all other parking violations shall not exceed \$75, if paid within 21 days, nor shall it exceed \$80 if  
5 paid thereafter, but before the parking clerk reports to the registrar as provided for under chapter  
6 90 section 20A 1/2 and shall not exceed \$100 if paid thereafter.

7           Section 2. The act shall take effect upon passage.
