An Act relative to investigators at the Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 72 of Chapter 10 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word ‘commission,’ in line 13, the
3 following:-

4 Said investigators shall have all the power of a reserve police officer in a city or town
5 with reference to enforcing the laws under chapter 138, excluding chapter 90.

6 SECTION 2. Section 56 of Chapter 138 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby
7 amended by inserting after the word ‘chapter,’ in line 11, the following:-

8 Said investigators shall have all the power of a reserve police officer in a city or town
9 with reference to enforcing the laws under chapter 138, excluding chapter 90.
