Tarr and Ann-Margaret Ferrante (with the approval of the mayor and city council) for legislation to authorize Cary Gould of the city of Gloucester to take the examination for appointment as a police officer in the city notwithstanding the maximum age requirement. 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The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

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**In the Year Two Thousand Fourteen**  
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An Act authorizing Cary Gould of the city of Gloucester to take the examination for appointment as a police officer in the city notwithstanding the maximum age requirement.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding chapter 31 of the General Laws or any other general or  
2 special law to the contrary regulating the maximum age of applicants for appointment to the  
3 position of a police officer in the city of Gloucester, Cary Gould of the city of Gloucester shall  
4 be eligible to take the next open, competitive examination for appointment as a police officer in  
5 the city of Gloucester and, if Cary Gould meets all other requirements, he shall be eligible for  
6 certification and appointment to that position.

7           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
