Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 17 of chapter 94C, as appearing in the 2016 Official Edition of the
- 2 General Laws, is hereby amended by striking out subsection (c) in its entirety and inserting in
- 3 place thereof the following:-
- 4 (c) A controlled substance included in Schedule III, IV, V or VI shall not be dispensed
- 5 without a written or oral prescription of a practitioner, except in emergency situations, as defined
- 6 and limited by rule or regulation of the commissioner acting jointly with the board of registration
- 7 in pharmacy.
