### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act relative to the Audit/Accountability office.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Sentence 1 of Section 55A of Chapter 15 is hereby amended by striking the
- 2 following: "within the department" and inserting: "within the Office of the State Auditor".
- 3 Sentence 2 of Section 55A of Chapter 15 is hereby amended by striking the following: "The
- 4 office shall provide a mechanism to review and report on the efforts of schools, charter schools
- 5 and school districts, including regional school districts, to improve the academic achievement of
- 6 their students and shall inform and assist the board and department in fulfilling their broader
- 7 responsibilities to promote high levels of achievement in the schools and districts of the
- 8 commonwealth." and inserting: "The office shall provide a mechanism to review and report on
- 9 the efforts of schools, charter schools and school districts, including regional school districts, to
- 10 improve the academic achievement of their students and shall inform and assist the board and
- 11 department in fulfilling their broader responsibilities to promote high levels of achievement in

- 12 the schools and districts of the commonwealth; the office will further present a prioritized list of
- 13 technical assistance that the department should provide to improve educational outcomes."
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on July 1, 2011.
