The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act establishing speed limits on portions of state highway route 28 and Chickatawbut road in the town of Milton.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of Chapter 90 of the General Laws, or any
- 2 other general or special law to the contrary, the motor vehicle speed limit for the approaches to
- 3 the intersection of state highway route 28 and Chickatawbut road, a department of conservation
- 4 and recreation park road, in the town of Milton and for the intersection itself shall be 25 miles
- 5 per hour. The Massachusetts Department of Transportation and the department of conservation
- 6 and recreation shall post the speed limit and take all actions necessary to implement the
- 7 established speed limit.
- 8 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
