In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act relative to student driver safety.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 8B of Chapter 90 of the General Laws as appearing in the 2018 Official Edition,

2 is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-

3 "The registrar shall provide the holder of a learner's permit or Junior Operator driver's 4 license with two copies of a highly visible, reflective decal, magnet or other appropriate symbol 5 as determined by the Registrar of Motor Vehicles, indicating that the driver of the vehicle may 6 be the holder of a learner's permit or Junior Operator driver's license. The registrar shall charge 7 a fee for the decal, magnet or other appropriate indicator. The symbol shall be displayed in a 8 manner prescribed by the registrar, and shall be clearly visible to law enforcement officers. The 9 holder of a learner's permit or Junior Operator restricted driver's license shall not operate a 10 vehicle unless the indicator is so displayed. Any individual found operating a motor vehicle in

- 11 violation of this paragraph shall pay a fine of not more than \$50. The registrar is hereby
- 12 authorized to promulgate regulations to assure the timely and effective implementation of this
- 13 paragraph."
