An Act relative to unmanned aerial vehicles in the Commonwealth.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 official edition, is
2	hereby amended by adding the following section:-
3	Section 63(a). As used in this section the following terms shall, unless the context clearly
4	requires otherwise, have the following meanings:-
5	"Drone," shall mean an unmanned aircraft which is operated remotely without the
6	possibility of direct human intervention from within or on the aircraft.
7	"Restricted space," shall mean an airspace within five miles of an airport or as designated
8	by general or special law.
9	(b) During the personal use of such drone, except as otherwise provided by federal law
10	operates a drone, a person shall not operate said drone: (i) more than four hundred feet above
11	ground level; (ii) weighing more than ten pounds; (iii) without a visual line of sight of such

- 12 drone; (iv) within a restricted airspace; (v) in a reckless manner wherein such operation creates a
- 13 risk of harm to the public; or (vi) with the intent to harass or annoy an individual or individuals.
